



All applications for school places are completed on-line via Lincolnshire County Council's School Admissions website:

Applications for places in the Reception class can be made from November. Applications for places in other year groups may be made at any time; these are known as 'mid-term' admissions.

The present policy is for all children to have the opportunity to start school in the September following their fourth birthday to enable three full years to be spent in the Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1.

Priority is given to children with older brothers or sisters already in school. The remaining places are allocated to children living in the villages of Uffington and Tallington and beyond. The school currently has children who live in Stamford, the Deepings, Bourne and local villages.

The school's Published Admissions Number is fifteen places in any one year group. We are not allowed, by law, to have classes of more than thirty children in an infant class. We follow the Lincolnshire County Council's Admissions Policy for Primary Schools which can be found on the school admissions website.
