French – Autumn Term – Year 5 and 6

. We focus on giving the children plenty of opportunities and experiences to practice their vocabulary and embed new vocabulary. Supporting them on their journey to being an independent learner.

To develop a deep interest in and appreciation for other cultures, as they learn to understand and express themselves with increasing confidence in the languages of other countries.

At Uffington Primary School the teaching of the languages curriculum helps our pupils develop their sense of belonging to the wider world, whilst encouraging them to embark on a journey towards a wealth of opportunities in their future lives. Pupils will develop specific knowledge of one language – French - learning words and structures that enable them to ask and answer questions, listen to, read and understand stories, songs, poems and other short texts, and to write from memory about themselves. At the same time, they will develop language learning skills and strategies that will equip them for the learning of additional languages.

Children will be taught in 2x 2 year cycles across Year 3 and 4, and then another 2 year cycle in Year 5 and 6. French progression document will show the development of the subject across the 2 cycles for both Y3 and 4 and then Y5 and 6.
