Home School Agreement

Introduction

This agreement recognises that a close partnership between home and school plays a very important part in a child's educational and social development.

Together, we hope to ensure that your child makes the best use of the opportunities provided by our school.

Therefore, the school will:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum in a happy, caring and safe environment;
- Let the parents know if there are any concerns with their child's work or behaviour;
- Keep parents informed about the curriculum and other school activities;
- Provide opportunities for parents to discuss their child's progress;
- Set and mark appropriate homework;
- Report annually to parents

The family will:

- Be responsible for ensuring the child's attendance and punctuality and inform the school of reasons for absence;
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems which may affect their child's work or behaviour;
- Show an interest in their child's school activities and provide guidance and support for homework;
- Make every effort to attend at least one Parents' Evening; and respond to teachers' concerns about work or behaviour
- Ensure that the school's dress code is implemented;
- Give due care and consideration to the safety of pupils when arriving at, and leaving school.
